2. Buy Bitcoin

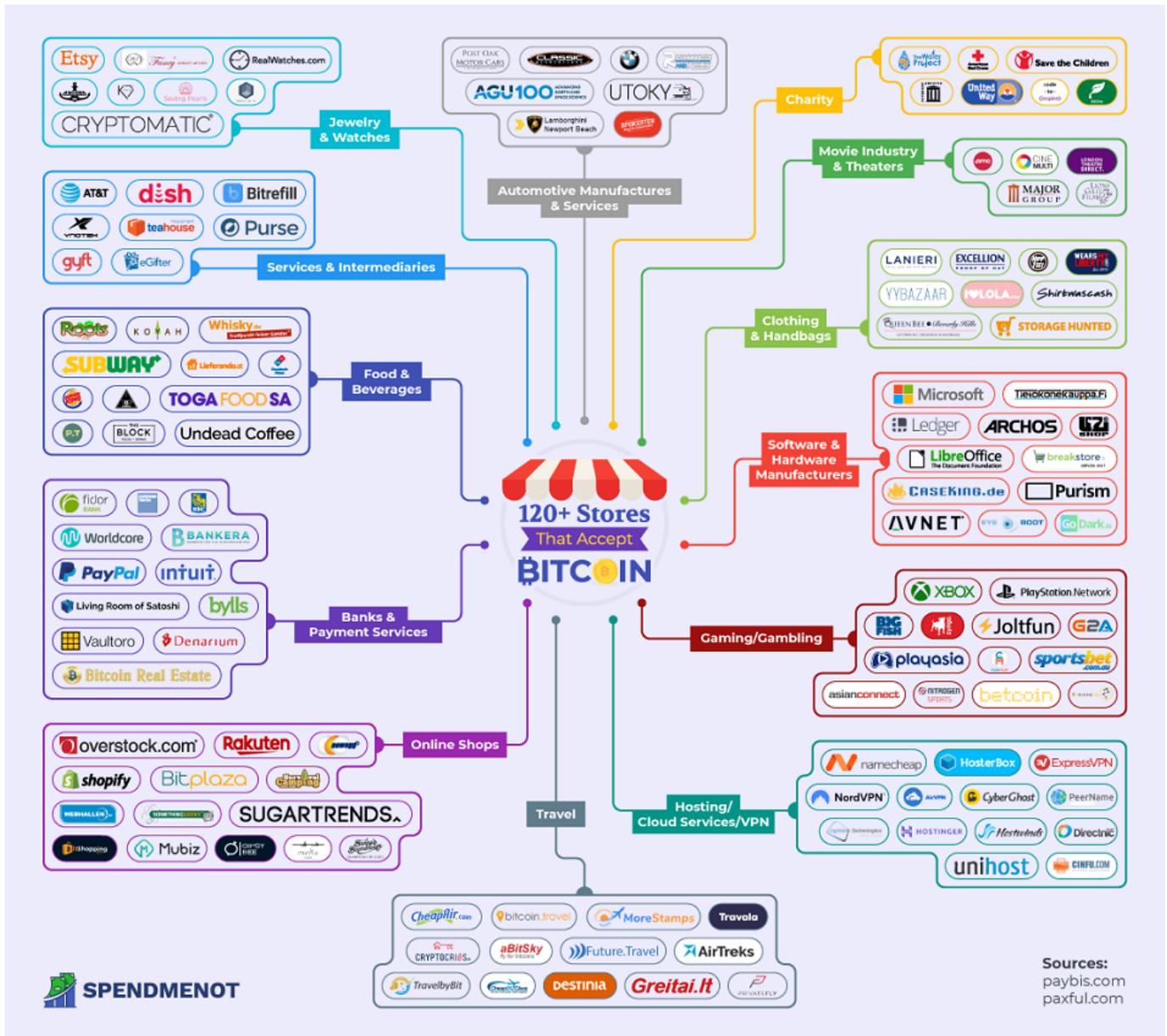
